Do you have <i>any</i> of the following symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fever (high temperature, or chills, night sweats) • a cough • sore throat • runny nose • loss of taste or smell • unexplained shortness of breath? 			<p>If Yes</p> <p>You cannot visit. If you have not had a throat/nasal swab for COVID-19 since getting these symptoms, book a test (phone 1800 671 738). Stay at home except to get tested, until you get the result. Do not visit until you have the result and your symptoms have stopped.</p>
<p>2. In the last 14 days, have you had contact with someone known or suspected to have COVID-19, or have you been asked by Public Health to quarantine or isolate at this time.</p> <p>(This does not apply if the contact has been at work, while wearing appropriate personal protective equipment)?</p>			<p>If Yes</p> <p>Go home. If Public Health has not contacted you about being a contact of someone with COVID-19, phone 1800 671 738.</p>
<p>3. Have you been to any COVID-19 exposure sites, either in Tasmania or interstate which require you to currently be in quarantine or avoiding high risk settings?</p>			<p>If Yes</p> <p>Go home, unless you have written exemption from the Director of Public Health or their delegate, to enter the facility.</p>
<p>4. Can you provide evidence that you are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 (2 doses of vaccine with the second dose being at least 2 weeks prior to visit).</p> <p>4.i If you cannot provide vaccination evidence, can you provide evidence of a negative result from a COVID-19 D7F test taken within the 72 hours prior to visit?</p> <p>4.ii If you cannot provide vaccination evidence, can you provide evidence of a negative result from a COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) negative result within 24 hours prior to visit?</p>			<p>If No, you cannot visit until you can provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test. This applies to all ages of visitors.</p> <p>If No, you cannot visit unless you have written exemption from the Director of Public Health or their delegate, to enter the facility.</p>
<p>5. Do you agree to wear a fitted face covering (face mask) while on the premises.</p> <p>6. Has everyone in your group used the Check-in TAS app (or similar) or provided their contact details for this visit?</p>			<p>If No, you cannot visit. Mask wearing is now mandatory. For children under the age of 12 masks are recommended but not mandatory.</p> <p>If No, do this now. Ask for help if you need it.</p>
