

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACT 2006

EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, PETER CARL GUTWEIN, the Premier of the State of Tasmania, am satisfied that there are reasonable grounds to extend the declaration of the state of emergency made by me on 19 March 2020 (and extended on 11 June 2020) in response to the coronavirus disease COVID-19 which endangers, or threatens to endanger, human life or causes or threatens injury or distress to persons in this State.

Pursuant to section 42(4) of the *Emergency Management Act 2006* ('the Act'), I extend the declaration of a state of emergency across the whole of Tasmania.

I authorise the State Controller to exercise all of the special emergency powers described in Schedule 2 of the Act.

The declaration will cease to have effect at 11:59pm on 31 August 2020.
