

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACT 2006

DIRECTIONS IN RELATION TO PERSONS ARRIVING IN TASMANIA

Preamble

A significant threat of an emergency is occurring in Tasmania due to the coronavirus disease COVID-19 ('the Disease'). To protect persons from distress, injury or death, I make the following directions in the exercise of emergency powers authorised under Section 40 of the *Emergency Management Act 2006* and pursuant to clause 1(1)(b) of Schedule 1 to that Act.

Commencement and Revocation

- (1) These directions take effect from 12:01am on 26 February 2022 and will continue in force until further notice.
- (2) The *Directions in relation to persons arriving in Tasmania* made by me on 18 January 2022 are revoked with effect from 12:01am on 26 February 2022.

Cruise Ships

- (3) A person, other than a crew member or person approved by the Deputy State Controller, is prohibited from entering Tasmania on a cruise ship.

Release from Quarantine

- (4) A person who is in quarantine pursuant to a Direction contained within the *Directions in relation to persons arriving in Tasmania* made on 18 January 2022, is no longer subject to such requirement.
